New initiatives

1. Pilot scheme on implementing electronic case papers.

From 13 July 2015, GOsC commenced a three month pilot extending the use of electronic case papers to members of the Investigating Committee. During the pilot, members of the Investigating Committee and the Legal Assessors, will have the access rights to case papers and other documents relevant to the cases they will be considering at the Investigating Committee meetings and interim suspension order hearings.
