

Visitors Response to the SIOM GOsC Monitoring Review Action Plan 2016

The responses from the visitors are set out, in summary, below.

The visitors concur with limiting the first ICOM cohort to 20 students as this will provide the opportunity for SIOM to test the arrangements in place ready for embedding within future cohorts.

Monitoring condition 1: there was agreement with the action specified.

Monitoring condition 2: the visitors reinforced the need to ensure that adequate transport links were available students to benefit from offsite clinics. There will be a need to report on the outcomes of the feedback from students through the module review questionnaire.

Monitoring condition 3: there was agreement with the action specified.

English language: there was agreement with the Executive and the SIOM response.

Clinical activity: the visitors felt that this should be monitored and that CPL students do not attend evening clinic sessions, when their working day including the evening clinic session was greater than 8 hours.

Progression agreement: there was agreement with the action specified.
