Background

1. The course closure plans for Leeds Beckett University (LBU) have been reported to previous meetings of the Committee.
2. This report provides a final update on the completed course closure.

Discussion

 - a. All remaining students have progressed and completed the requirements for graduation and registration. One student withdrew prior to completing the course.
