

GOsC registration fee consultation

A GOSC Council proposal to reduce the 2013-14 registration fees paid to the GOSC by osteopaths was the subject of a public consultation conducted by the GOSC between 26 October 2012 and 25 November 2012.

The fee consultation asked two questions:

Question 1: do you agree that identified savings should be passed back to the profession via a fee reduction?

Question 2: should the reduction in fees be focused on the highest fee of £675 (option 1) or applied as an across the board fee reduction (option 2)?

Results

Responses to the consultation were received via the GOsC public website and the **o** zone with a few responses submitted in the post or by email. The results of the fee consultation are as follows:

Total 557

Of the 557 responses, 11 were written responses only.

Question 1: do you agree that identified savings should be passed back to the profession via a fee reduction?

Yes	536	98.17%
No	10	1.83%

Question 2: should the reduction in fees be focused on the highest fee of £675 (option 1) or applied as an across the board fee reduction (option 2)?

Option 1 351 65.54% Option 2 184 34.46%

NB: Please note that the total number of logged responses to consultation question 2 is 11 fewer for the following reasons.

- 10 fewer responses as question 1 was answered 'No'
- 1 fewer response as question 2 was not answered
