Code of practice review

As the UK regulator of osteopaths, the General Osteopathic Council has a legal duty to publish, and keep under review, the Code of Practice for osteopaths. The Code contains advice on the practice of osteopathy and the principles of personal and professional conduct.

We are now in the early stages of revising the current Code of Practice, which was issued in 2005. To ensure the Code remains relevant to current practice, we are keen to gain feedback on areas that you think need updating.
