Fiona Walsh is a member of the Finance and General Purposes Committee, and was a member of the previous Council.

She graduated from the British School of Osteopathy (BSO) in 1977, and has since been a senior lecturer in technique and senior clinical tutor teaching osteopathy at the BSO and the Vienna School of Osteopathy. She works in private practice and also, since 1994, has delivered osteopathy in a NHS setting in two large GP training practices in London.

Fiona was the last Chairman of the General Council and Register of Osteopaths - a voluntary register in existence before statutory regulation was introduced - and was directly involved in the transition from voluntary to statutory regulation. She is an external examiner in the UK and throughout Europe with a wide-ranging experience of validation and accreditation with the Open University, the University of Wales and the University of Westminster.
