#### **GOsC BUSINESS PLAN 2019-20**

The General Osteopathic Council has agreed a corporate plan for 2019-2024 which commits the organisation to a programme of work with six themes. These are:

- 1. Assuring the quality of osteopathic education and training.
- 2. Registering qualified professionals and assuring their continuing fitness to practise.
- 3. Setting, maintaining and promoting high standards of practice and conduct.
- 4. Protecting patients and the public through transparent and proportionate fitness to practise processes that reflect best practice.
- 5. Supporting the ongoing development of the osteopathic profession.
- 6. Maintaining high standards of governance and regulatory practice.

This document, the Business Plan 2019-20, sets out the aims and detailed activities for the period April 2019 to March 2020, in support of each of the themes.

Our core goals: Working with our quality assurance partner and UK osteopathic educational providers to ensure that recognised qualifications are only awarded to students who are able to practise in accordance with the Osteopathic Practice Standards (OPS).
