Ongoing: this work has been delayed as the GOsC needed to engage in responding in-depth, to questions arising from the PSA Performance Review Process. The Executive expect to have concluded this activity by September 2024.

Ongoing: the Executive will reflect on the benefit of producing an annual registration report and will present to Council its conclusions within the next registration update in November 2024.

Ongoing: we awaiting confirmation from the Privy Council that the qualifications have been renewed.
