Key messages from paper:

- Each year there are non-executive appointments and reappointments which need to be managed.
- Council electronically approved the appointment of four new members of the Investigating Committee and Professional Conduct Committee in March 2021. This paper formally notes their appointment from 1 April 2021.
- There are four appointments needed to the Governance structure in 2021-22 and one reappointment.

Background

1. Members of Council and other non-executive positions have set terms of office. Each year we are required to undertaken appointment and reappointment activity and this paper provides oversight to Council.

Discussion

Fitness to Practise appointments

- 2. In March 2021, Council electronically approved the appointment of four new members of the fitness to practise panels. The appointments, which all have the term of office from 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2025, are:
 - Andrew Harvey, Chair of the Professional Conduct Committee (PCC)
 - Rasila Jassal, PCC lay member and panel chair
 - Melissa D'Mello, PCC lay member
 - Helena Suffield-Thompson, Investigating Committee lay member and panel chair

Non-Executive appointments

3. In 2021-22, there are four positions which require an appointment process. These relate to: an independent member of the Audit Committee; to replace one lay member of the Professional Conduct Committee; to fill the registrant member vacancy on the Investigating Committee; and an internal process to appoint a Chair of the Health Committee.

Non-Executive reappointments

4. In 2021-22, there is one fitness to practise panellist who is eligible for reappointment.
