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Background

1. At the last Education and Registration Standards Committee meeting in February 2014, the Committee agreed draft terms of reference for a professionalism working group for discussion with stakeholders.

3. At the General Osteopathic Council (GOsC)/osteopathic educational institution meeting on 3 June 2014, the group agreed the draft terms of reference proposed.
