professionals

How you select, record and reflect on CPD activities.

How you discuss your CPD and concerns with others.

How you use the GOsC CPD resources and your preferred methods of communication

It would be helpful for you to have your most recent CPD Annual Summary form in front of you when completing the questionnaire and perhaps also a copy of the *Osteopathic Practice Standards*.

Once you have completed the questionnaire you will be able to save an electronic copy of your responses to keep in your CPD record folder as evidence or print a copy if you prefer.

You will be able to claim 30 minutes of CPD for completion of the questionnaire, along with any additional time spent reflecting on the content and what that means for you either individually or collectively with a colleague.

All responses will be confidential and anonymous. There is no way of linking data to respondents.
