Step 1 Enrolment by 14 August 2011

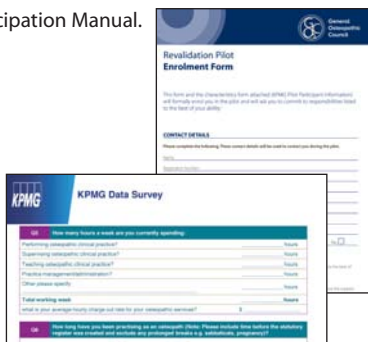
- > Read your Revalidation Pilot Participation Manual.

STEP 4 PROVIDING FEEDBACK

Complete an evaluation form and return to KPMG.

September 2012

- > Complete a piece of evidence.
- > Collate professional development folder and self assessment form and send to GOsC.
- > Provide final feedback to KPMG and receive confirmation of completion.

Step 5 Completing the Pilot by 30 September 2012

- > See Section 5 of the Guidelines for Osteopaths Seeking Revalidation.
- > Submit your folder to the GOsC before the deadline to ensure it counts.
- > Claim your CPD hours from the GOsC.
- > Tell KPMG about your experiences to inform future thinking and consultation.
- > Tell health professionals that you have completed the GOsC Revalidation Pilot.
