#### Introduction

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, we must adopt and maintain a 'publication scheme' so that information can be made routinely available to the public.

We make information available to the public as part of our normal business activities, and this is also a requirement under the Act.

The General Osteopathic Council (GOsC) has adopted the **model publication scheme** for public authorities approved by the Information Commissioner. The model scheme sets out our obligations with regard to publishing and providing information and describes the kinds (classes) of information we should make available.

Further information about your rights under the Freedom of Information Act is also available on the Information Commissioner's website.

Our publication scheme also follows the Information Commissioner's recommendations for the specific types of information that health regulators are expected to publish and make available in each of the classes defined in the model publication scheme. These expectations are set out by the Information Commissioner in a **definition document.**

#### The types of information we provide

We provide the following types of information:

1. Who we are and what we do Organisational information, structures, locations and contacts

#### 2. What we spend and how we spend it

Financial information relating to projected and actual income and expenditure and financial audit

#### 3. What our priorities are and how we are doing

Strategies and plans, performance indicators and reviews

#### 4. How we make decisions

Decision making processes and records of decisions

#### 5. Our policies and procedures

Current written protocols, policies and procedures for delivering our services and responsibilities

#### 6. Lists and registers

Any information we are currently legally required to hold in publicly available registers, including the Statutory Register of Osteopaths.

#### 7. The services we offer

Information about the services we offer, leaflets and guidance produced for the public and businesses. Details of the services for which we are entitled to recover a fee together with those fees.

#### How to get information

Most of the information in our publication scheme is available to read or download from our website. If certain information is not available on the website, the guide to information (see the **Guide to information** section below) explains how you can obtain it.

If the information you require is not included in the publication scheme, you can request it using <u>the FOI Request Form</u>, by post or email to:

Most of the information is free, but we may make a charge for particular items. This is indicated in the guide to information (see the **Guide to information** section below) and we will let you know of any relevant charges when we reply to your request. Please also see the section below called **Publication scheme charges**.

We are committed to ensuring the accessibility of all the information we produce. For those without access to the Internet, or who would prefer to receive paper copies of website pages or documents that are downloadable from the website, we will supply single paper copies free of charge. #### **Publication scheme charges**

Information in our publication scheme is normally available free of charge. Most of the information in the scheme is freely available on our website. Single print-outs of website pages, if required, will be normally be made available free of charge.

Single copies of most of our printed publications are available to the public free of charge and can be ordered from the Osteopathic Information Service on 020 7357 6655 x242; email: <u>info@osteopathy.org.uk</u>. Where single copies are charged for, or the information is available from elsewhere in the GOsC, we indicate it in the guide to information.

We may make charges for:

- producing multiple copies in paper or other formats;
- certain hard copy publications;
- postage.

We charge for a public version of the transcript of a fitness to practise hearing to be made (free copies are only supplied to parties to the hearing). Depending on the redactions and editing that may be required, costs can vary, but start from £2.00 per page and include postage and packing for hard copies. We can give quotations on request and will need payment in advance.

We will let you know how much this will cost when you request the information and we may ask you for payment in advance.

#### **Guide to information**

As part of our publication scheme we provide a guide to the information we publish, which includes how each document can be obtained and whether there is any charge for it.
